## Ninth Newman Pilgrimage Paul and Barnabas in Cyprus – April 2009

With the Vatican celebrating the year June 2008 to June 2009 as the Year of St Paul, marking the 2000th anniversary of his birth, we revived our Pauline journeys for our ninth Newman Pilgrimage. The theme was *Paul and Barnabas in Cyprus* and was from **29th April to 6th May 2009**. Those pilgrims who were on the *St Paul in Anatolia* pilgrimage followed the route of Paul and Barnabas from Antioch to Selucia where they sailed to Salamis and later the pilgrimage rejoined their route at Perge where they had sailed from Paphos. In this pilgrimage we followed their route across Cyprus visiting a range of historical sites including Salamis and Famagusta; Nicosea and Tamassos; Larnaca, Curium, Trudos Mountain churches and Paphos.
